Title: Entering Art Shows - A Step-by-Step Guide to Success

Description: As part of the Heritage Fine Arts Guild monthly meeting, Trish Sangelo is giving a presentation on how to successfully enter art shows—from digital entry to improving your chances of winning an award! Open to members and non-members alike, this special session is intended to help increase your confidence and process in submitting your artwork to "This is Colorado" and other art shows you are thinking of entering.

Topics to be covered:

- Tips and tricks on photographing artwork and generating image files suitable for digital entry.
- Paying attention to the fine print in the prospectus; ensuring your pieces are eligible.
- How to select paintings to entering (cohesive, professional representation and other things judges may looking for)
- The entry process with a step-by-step demonstration using the ACC show submission page.
- Preparing your artwork for hanging with tips on matting and framing, suitable hanging methods/supplies
- Etiquette for artwork delivery/retrieval and participation in show-related activities/events

April Demo with Jo Anne Nelson



In a very engaging demo—and as an enticing intro to her upcoming mixedmedia/collage (May 18) workshop—Jo Ann showed us different ways to create solid, textured substrates. From found wood panels and trim to Masonite remnants, Elmer's Glue-All instead of medium, house paint in lieu of Gesso, Jo Ann shared ideas on how to create economical versions of the expensive, ready-made items sold at art supply stores. She explained collage and mixed-media techniques using all kinds of materials and repurposed objects, including different kinds of paper, photographs, cheese cloth, stencils and spackle, rusty old metal objects, and even highway sign reflector beads clearly a luck find! The possibilities are virtually endless, but the most important thing is to have a PLAN—to *tell a story!* Even if the viewer won't fully understand what's behind the painting or collage piece you are creating,

fully understand what's behind the painting or collage piece you are creating, if there's a story, the viewer *will* sense it and be drawn in, trying to figure out what it means and what your intentions might have been. It's a great way to

connect and make your art truly *engaging*!

Submission requirements and details for the Best of Heritage/Bemis Library Members Show:

• Application fee is \$30.00 for 3 entries per artist member. All selected art will remain in the library from June 1-June 30, 2024. Sales are handled by the individual artist.

 All art must be clean and framed or have finished edges. All pieces must be hung using a D-ring and wire securing system. No sawtooth hangers or metal screw eyes are acceptable. ● Please submit a digital image of each painting along with your Entry Form.

Digital images (no larger than 1.5 Mb.) must be cropped to show only the painting (no mat, frame or other background in the picture). Please label your image file with your name, the title of the piece, medium, size (framed) and price or NFS. (for example: ssmith_Challenge_collage_30x30_475).
Selected work is to be delivered to Bemis Public Library, 6014 S. Datura Street, Littleton Colorado, 80120, between 9-11 am on Saturday, June 1, 2024. 
This is Colorado at Arapahoe Community College - August 22- -September 26, 2024. Art drop off is August 19th with the reception on September 22, 2024.
